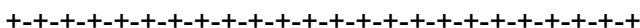
Equality, Diversity and Inclusion (EDI) officer

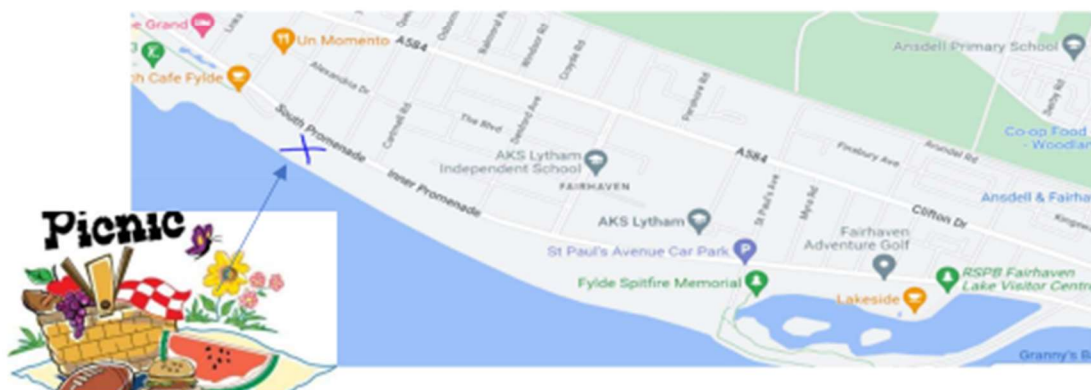
